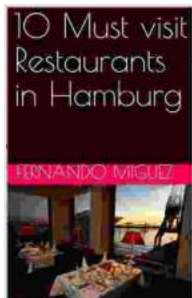


10 Must-Visit Restaurants in Hamburg: A Culinary Tour of the Hanseatic City

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1. Fischereihafen Restaurant



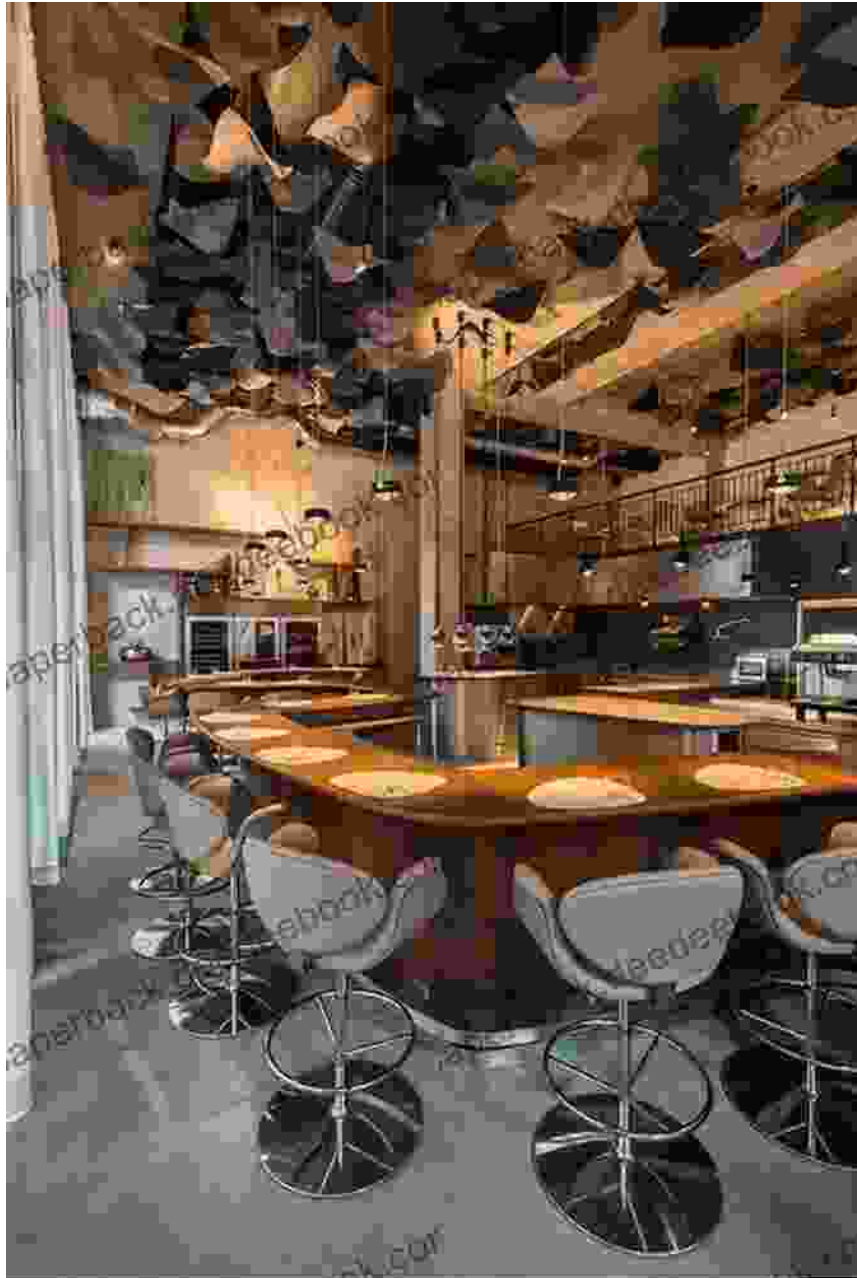

2. St. Oberholz Coffee



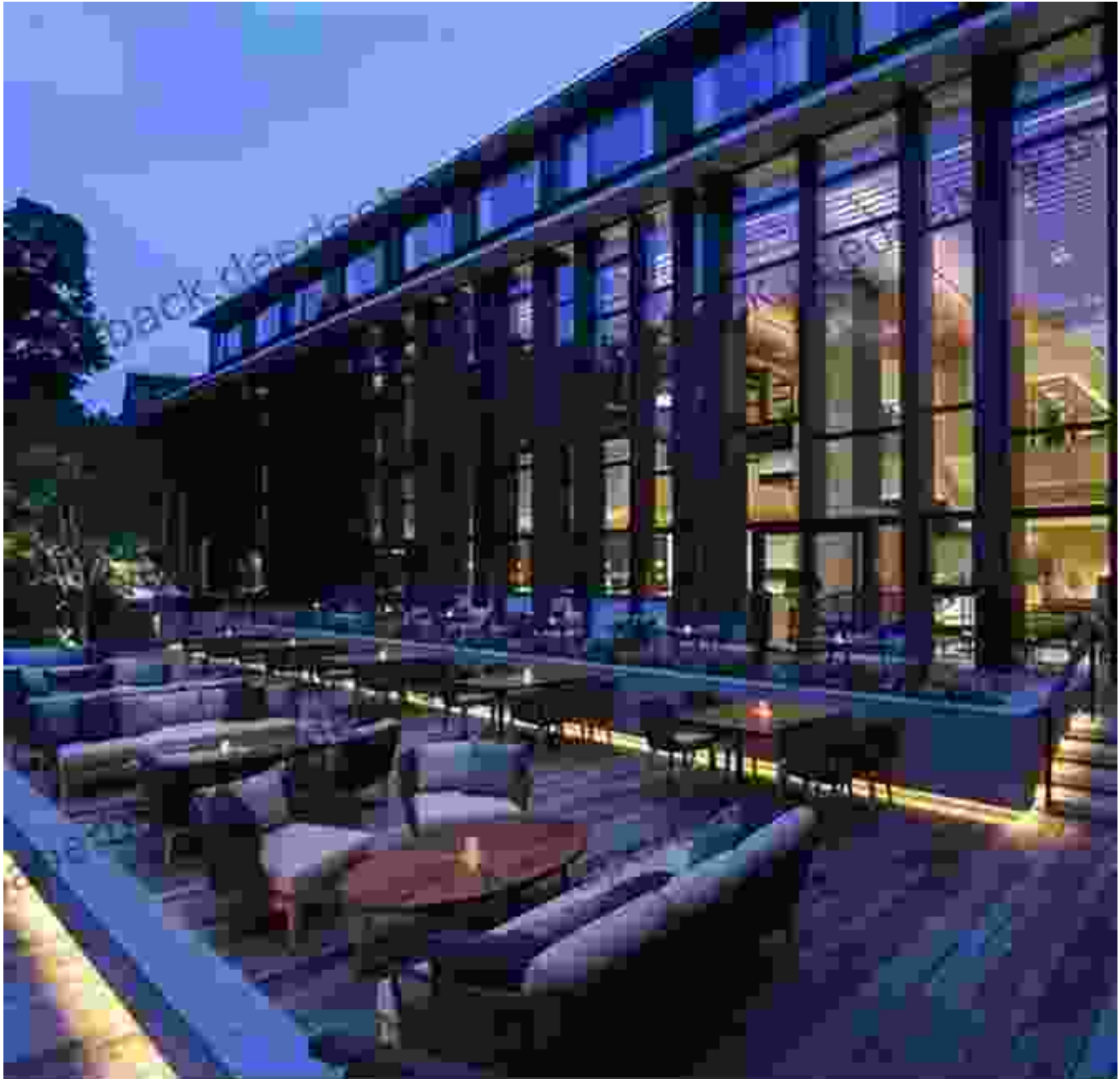

9. Hafenkantine



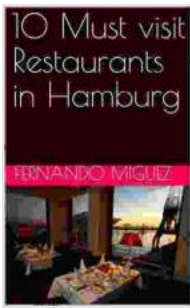

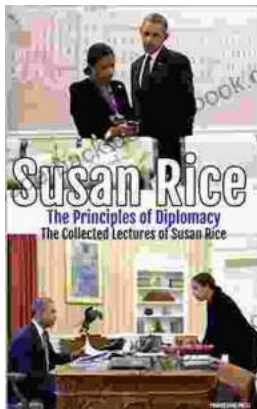

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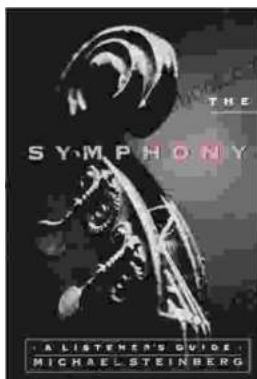
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
