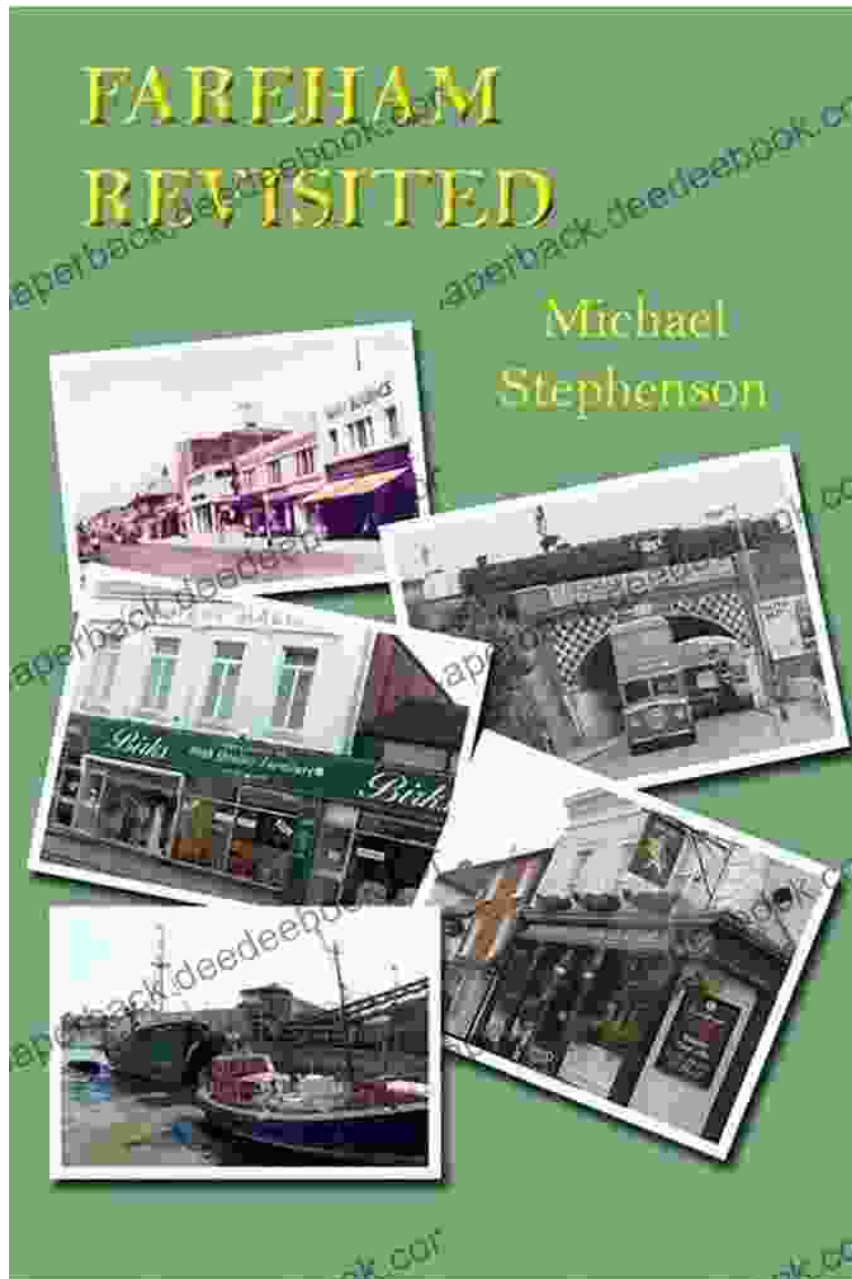


Jane Austen's Fareham

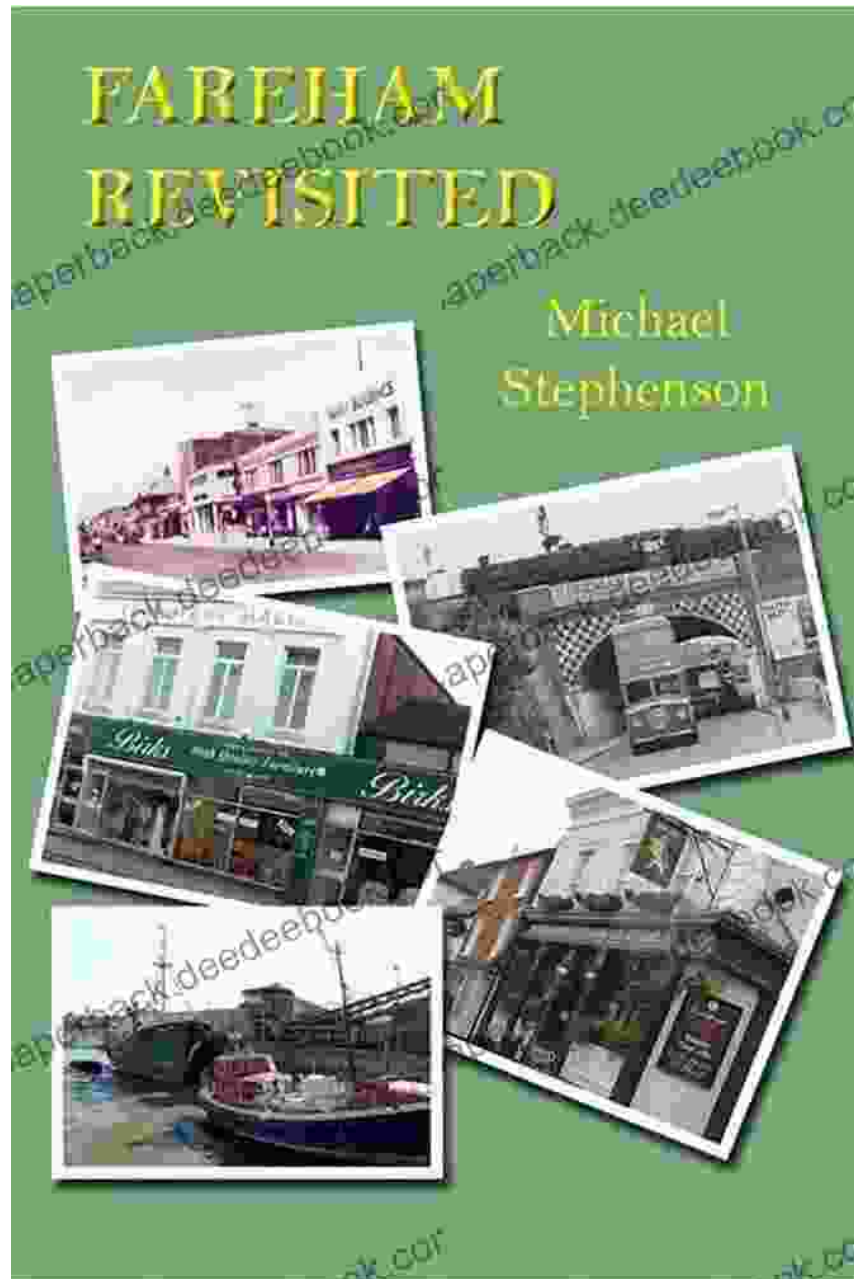

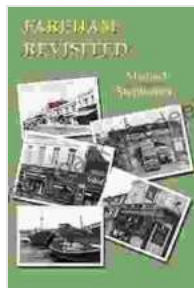

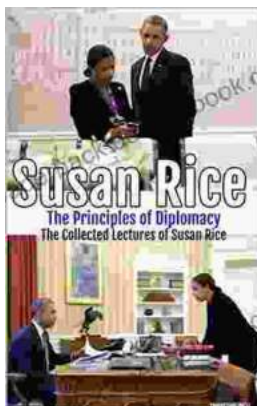
