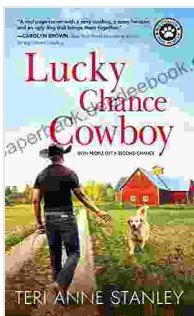


Love Big: Veteran Rancher Woos an Overworked and Jaded Woman

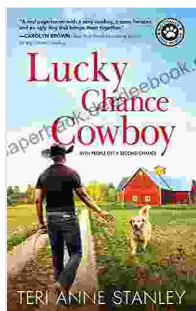

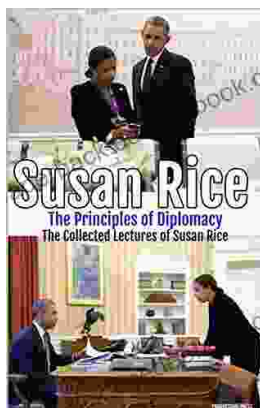

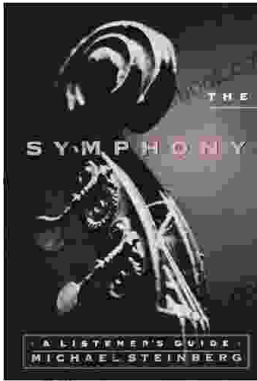
