- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn
- Size H crochet hook
- Scissors

3. Double crochet 11 times into the ring.
4. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.
5. Chain 2 and single crochet around the edge of the circle.
6. Continue single crocheting around the circle, increasing 6 stitches evenly around.
7. Repeat Step 6 until the hat is the desired size.
8. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

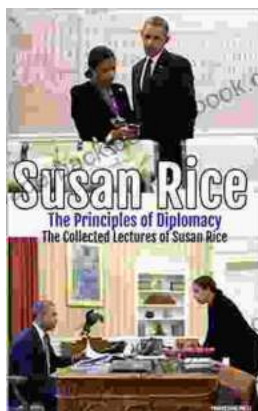
