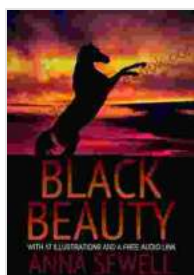

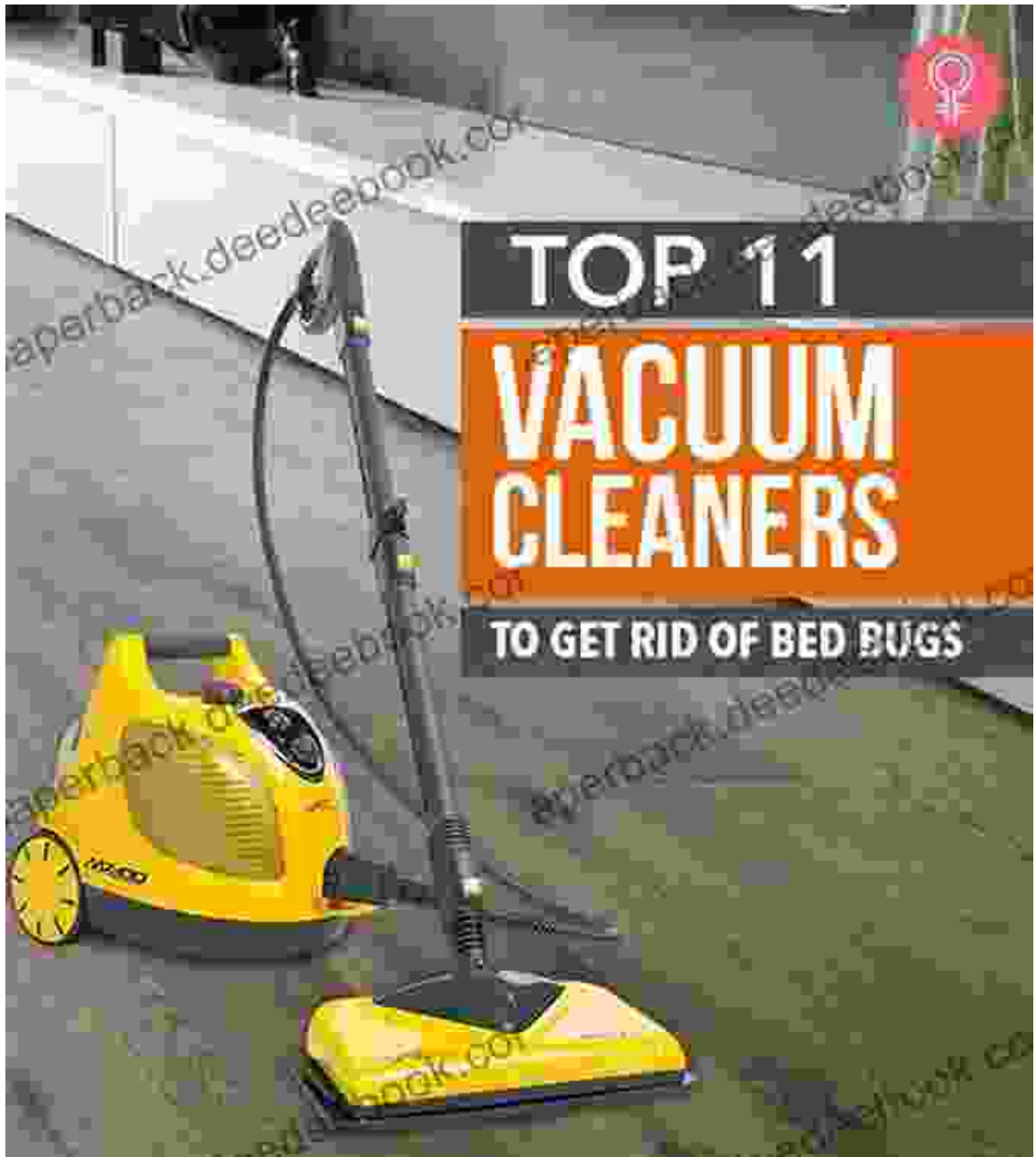

WHAT YOU'LL NEED



Credit card

Check through all the entry and the utility with doors, walls, compressed lights, etc.



Flashlight

SIGNS OF BED BUG INFESTATIONS

-  Small, round, reddish-brown bugs
-  Crawling around and blood stains on "stain" white
-  4-6 legs, small, oval
-  Marked gum or smears in some and long hair

- Take off the sheets and blankets to inspect your mattress.
- Check the corners of the bed, sheets, and blankets.
- Inspect all the pillows in the room, including extra ones in the closet and floor other furniture in the room.
- Check the cracks, joints, and seams of all the beds and furniture. Use your card to scrape along these sides.
- Go through the rest of the surrounding furniture with your card: (Dresser, chairs, couches, cars, and bed headboards)
- Investigate the curtain, desk, and nightstand for some signs of infestation.
- Insure the room for any smears, stains, marks, smelly that suggests blood.

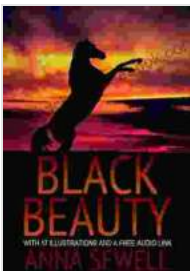

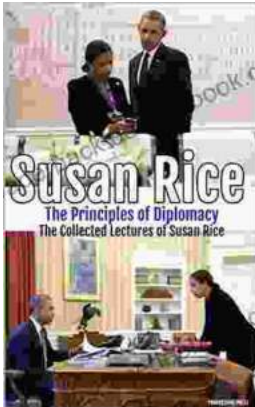
